For the membership to be attributed to your Tennis Club once you have signed up you are able to Log in to your area, where you can then add your club (Queniborough) to your profile.

Click Profile, then Club/ Park Membership and add your Club.

Also you must be a British Tennis Member if you would like to go into the Wimbledon Ballot.
